**(Richmond, California) – Fatal DUI Collision at Ohio Ave./ S.20th St.**

On Monday, July 15th, at 12:01AM, officers responded to a two-vehicle collision near S. 20th St. and Ohio Ave. Officers arrived within two minutes and located two vehicles that had major damage with drivers being trapped inside.

The driver and sole occupant of one of the vehicles, a 16-year-old male, was trapped in the vehicle and succumbed to his injuries at the scene.

The driver and sole occupant of the second vehicle, Alexi Pineda Ticas, age 30, required extrication from his vehicle provided by Richmond Fire. Ticas sustained minor injuries and displayed objective signs of intoxication. Ticas was transported to a nearby medical center where he received medical treatment prior to being booked at the RPD jail. Ticas is being charged with vehicular manslaughter, with gross negligence and driving under the influence of alcohol resulting in injury.

The preliminary investigation suggests that both speeding, and alcohol may have been factors in this collision. The RPD traffic unit is continuing to investigate this collision.

We urge the public to make responsible decisions when driving a vehicle and arrange for a designated driver, use public transportation, or call a rideshare service.
